HDIAC Journal Article Submission Guidelines

Formats and Guidelines

All articles must be relevant to one of HDIAC's eight focus areas (alternative energy, biometrics, CBRN defense, critical infrastructure protection, cultural studies, homeland defense and security, medical and weapons of mass destruction) and relate to Department of Defense applications.

Each article submission must be written from a DoD perspective and contain Scientific and Technical Information.

The HDIAC Journal does not publish reprints of previously published articles. All articles must be original and contain proper sourcing and citation information. The HDIAC Journal uses APA style for references.

In addition to editing for style, grammar and content, HDIAC will check for plagiarism and authoritative sourcing. HDIAC will immediately return any articles containing plagiarism to the author.

Submit articles electronically as a Microsoft Word document. We require a maximum of 3,000 words.

All submissions must include graphics or images to accompany the article. These images must be approved for publication and HDIAC will require written permission from the image creator or copyright holder. Photo or image credit should be included in the caption. All images must be print quality (300 or higher DPI in JPG or PNG format) to allow for resizing and adjustments.

HDIAC requires documentation that your article has been cleared for public release. This can be as simple as a confirmation in an email that the article has been reviewed and approved for release.

Author Bios and Contact Information:

All articles must include a brief biography (fewer than 100 words) and head shot to be included in the publication. HDIAC also requires contact information (name, title, and email address) to accompany the article.
